Basic information

- Price \$2985 plus tax. (If exchange rate increases more than 10%, a program surcharge will be instituted)

Questions?

1. Is there a deposit due?

-There is a \$500 (\$400 nonrefundable) deposit due by February 25th .

2. Can you make installment payments for the balance of the trip?

- Yes! You can make five payments of \$497.80 (March 1, April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1) All payments are to be made through the MWW Business Paypal account or through its Google Payments account. Taxes are to be paid in May with a separate payment. ***Fewer payments can be arranged.***

3. What if I have to cancel?

-\$400 of your deposit is non refundable. Any other refund depends on how far along we are in booking the trip. We are a small educational organization not a tour agency.

4. How many people are going?

- At least 10.

5. How many people in my room with me?

- Depends on the accommodation. Sometimes there will be one person, sometimes more (i.e. Apartment)

6. Will there be free time?

-Yes, there will be some free time every day to rest or explore. There is also an optional trip to Disneyland Paris.

7. What if I want to leave from somewhere other than Seattle?

-You will be responsible for any additional travel details to get to Seattle or extra costs from your own city.

8. Will there be any pre-education?

- Yes, there will be a Seattle session for local people. We'll Skype in everyone else on that day.
